If further information is required, postage-stamp-sized pieces of tissue may be retained for examination under the microscope or samples of body fluids taken for analysis in the laboratory.*

*Cells from tumours are tested to see if they have these receptors. If so, hormone (or endocrine) therapy may be used as a treatment. Before menopause the female hormones oestrogen and progesterone are produced by the ovaries. After menopause oestrogen is made in body fat, such as that found in the breast.*
